

## **DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY**

Our April meeting explored using phones for photography including the pros and cons compared with shooting with cameras. Modern phones can produce excellent images but one needs to be aware that they have very small sensors. This means that they have very small pixels so you need to think what you are going to do with the images. Enlarging them for projection or prints or cropping sections of them out means that definition is lost and they become blurred. Phones have lots of features but you need to explore to discover them and this can mean going through several menus. Some modern cameras share this menu driven system rather than the easier to access dials and buttons.

In May we continued our tradition of going out on a photo shoot. This time it was just down the road at Levens Hall where there are great opportunities for photography in the gardens.
